We work with beverage and food repack as well as co-packing, assembling medical components, filling intricate component packing, point of purchase display assembling, and packaging for shipping. We provide kitting of all types and difficulties, and pack-outs at all levels of detail and custom handwork.

Projects may include:

- Manual intensive handwork for jobs of all sizes
- Building and filling point of purchase displays
- Medical component assembling, kitting, and packaging
- Repacking of palletized cases of single flavor drink cans such as beers, teas, custom health drinks, and carbonated water into smaller variety packs
- Cosmetic kitting and packaging
- Collating, labeling of marketing pieces, and preparation for mailing
- Box assembling, and packaging for distribution
- Weighing, and packing semi-solid materials
- Collating, packaging, and boxing custom printed advertising materials
- Shrink wrapping and palletized products
- Component Procurement

Our workshop area is 30,000 square feet with 200+ workers ready to work on your job! We have 10,000 square feet of warehouse space, advanced warehouse inventory software, trailer space, three docks doors capable of receiving 53' trailers, one 26 ft truck for product pickup and delivery, with 10 pallet positions and 101 inches in height, a Shanklin A27A shrink tunnel, Weldotron 601 L-Bar impulse sealers, digital scale, manual heat sealers, and rack space to hold over 400 pallets.

By contracting with HCOC, you empower individuals with disabilities to learn skills and processes, which enables them to be skilled and willing employees in the future. Our workers are fully capable of manual intensive handwork, and with high-level workshop supervision, our workers deliver products that conform to strict quality assurance specifications. Each job adheres to customer productions schedules and deliveries are on time. Many of our workers experience employment barriers due to physical disabilities, cerebral palsy, blindness, traumatic brain injuries, or a mental health diagnosis. By providing special training, tools, and supports, we ensure that they become good candidates for hire outside of our skilled work centers in the future. Each skill center has up to a 15:1 ration of workers to supervisor.
